"Ms Car-men"

Act description

- 1 female performer, duration 5 minutes,
- suitable for cabaret, corporate events, night clubs, theatres
- suitable for any age group
- Music: CD, "Habanera" by "Angela Gheorghiu", Carmen, Bizet.

"Ms Car-men" is a classical Clown performance on the aerial ladder.



The task of Car-men (the name refers to the ladies beard) is to tell the story of "L'amour" (Love) by singing playback opera plus performing a routine on the aerial ladder. The first two minutes are performed on the floor and it is uncertain at the beginning if this is a serious attempt at flamenco dancing or if it is a funny act. But soon things go wrong, Car-men got chased by the ladder, the dress is too tight to climb, there are problems with her long hair and finally she gets stuck with her big boobs.

Technical requirements: Single point aerial ladder.

If you are not sure, that your location offers the necessary technical requirements, don't hesitate to contact me. Although there are particular requirements, some adjustments may be possible.

One or two (preferable for a pulley system) fixed point(s) on the ceiling. Point(s) have to be fixed and not moving. The rigging point(s) must hold 1000 lbs or 500 kg. The minimum height is 17ft or 5m, from rigging point to the floor. The maximum height is variable, but has to be confirmed in advance. The positioning of the ladder should be centre stage. Airspace around the ladder and floor space has to be clear in a diameter of 6 meter and clearly visible (not obstructed by any objects). Fixture points must be easily accessible by hydraulic ramps, ladders or similar devices.

Lighting: The ladder (up to 2.5 m above the ladder as well as space from floor up to the ladder) and stage should be lighted with general cover from at least four sides. Can be variable depending on available technical facilities, but have to be confirmed beforehand.

Music: Sound system must be available

Stage set up time: 1 - 3 hours depending on the location
